Aims and Objectives of Hifz Class

Aim: To memorise the Qur'an to gain the Happiness of Allah.

Objective: To make effort, adhering to all the rules of Islam and Madrasah, to the best of one's capability.

Rules and Regulations

At Home:

1. Students must learn their daily Sabaq, Sabaq Para and Dor at home.
2. Students should be punctual with all their salah. Preferably performing it here at Madani Education Centre.
3. Students should try to wear Islamic clothing out of Madrasah also. At least they should wear a topi.
4. Students are expected to have Islamic haircuts.
5. Students must also keep a beard. Shaving/trimming it will result in expulsion.

In Madrasah:

1. Students must be punctual with Madrasah. They must arrive in class by 5:10pm. Petty excuses for being absent will not be tolerated.
2. Hifz class timings are 5:10pm – 7.40pm (unless a salah time is after this, in which case they will need to perform salah and then go home).
3. Students should be prepared to attend out of hour's class to make up for any shortcomings during the week.
4. Students will also be expected to attend class every Saturday from 9am till 11am.
5. Students will need to purchase a hifz diary which will show their progress and the parents will be expected to sign it daily.
6. Fees will be £60 per month for 11 months (£660 for a whole year).
7. Students will only be able to start memorising the Qur'an after their tajweed is up to our standards.
8. After completing each para/juz a student will have to pass a test before moving on to the next para/juz.
9. If a student forgets his dor (previous paras) then his sabaq will be stopped and he will be made to perfect his dor before continuing with sabaq.
10. After completing hifz, a student must complete 10 full Qur'an dors before his hifz khatm takes place.
11. Students must not commit to any extracurricular activities that are likely to disrupt their Madrasah attendance and learning.
